PARCR was founded by residents of retirement communities to assist other facilities in establishing elected, effective resident's councils, networking among members, legislative reports, and speakers of interest to the group.

PARCR is the network of residents involved in governance of their facilities. PARC provides access to resources and options for residents of existing residents' councils or to those individuals interested in establishing such an organization.

PARCR Provides the Following Services:

ASSISTANCE to member residents' councils and potential councils through personal contact. The assistance includes meeting with administration and/or resident representatives; identifying leadership traits and goals; and presentations to groups of residents to stimulate enthusiasm for resident' council organizations.

EDUCATION to residents and administration-on the problems, pitfalls and solutions in developing effective residents' councils.

ADVOCACY on state, national and local levels regarding the issues confronting seniors, particularly from the perspective of residents in retirement communities.

PROGRAMS on long term care, managed care, health services, current issues and trends, legislative and policy concerns.

ENCOURAGEMENT for the development of effective, mutually beneficial relationships between residents and administration.



Membership Information

Full Membership: Full membership is open to recognized delegates of the residents' council or governance structure of a facility; Annual fees are \$60 per facility. Membership is held by the residents' council designees from the facility.

Associates Membership: Any resident of a facility which is a member of PARCR can join for \$20 per year.
