The LeadingAge PA government affairs team developed an *Advocacy at a Glance 2022 Dashboard* to be used as a tool to give members insight into legislation and topics it has supported or opposed during the 2021-2022 legislative session and the advocacy actions that has been taken on behalf of members. Within this dashboard, LeadingAge PA has broken down the legislation into topics that relate to each aging services setting. By doing so, the dashboard provides a description of the topic, LeadingAge PA's position on the matter and if it has been accomplished or is still pending into the new year. Additionally, notes are provided to further detail the outcomes of the topics. Those items that are still pending may be reintroduced in the next legislative session starting in January, so LeadingAge PA will continue to track them and advocate for our members' best interests.
